Scanner Set-Up Guide for MacOS

Overview

Remote Deposit Capture is a service provided by Redwood Credit Union, which allows business owners to deposit multiple checks at a time to their RCU account using a scanner to capture and submit check images.

System Requirements

Setting up your system

For an optimal experience the following components are required for working with the application.

For MacOS:

- MacOS 11 Big Sur: Google Chrome™
- MacOS 12 Monterey: Google Chrome™
- MacOS 13 Ventura: Google Chrome™
- MacOS 14 Sonoma: Google Chrome™

Install Check Scanner

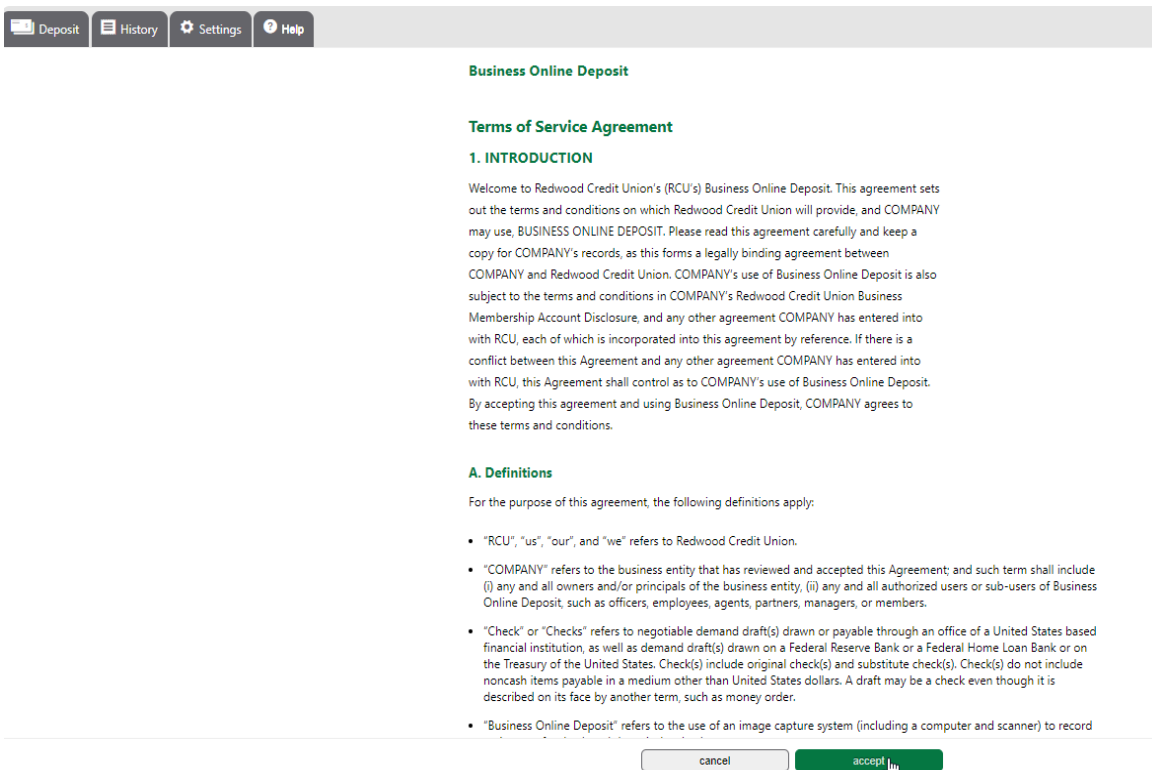
Check Scanner Setup

Prior to installation, it is required that all existing check scanner drivers are removed from your Mac. This must be done before continuing to the next steps.

1. Make sure the scanner is unplugged from the computer. Log into Digital Banking and click **Remote Deposit Capture**



2. Accept the disclosure and you will be prompted to download the **Ensenta Device Control Launcher** that will prompt you to install the supported drivers within Digital Banking.

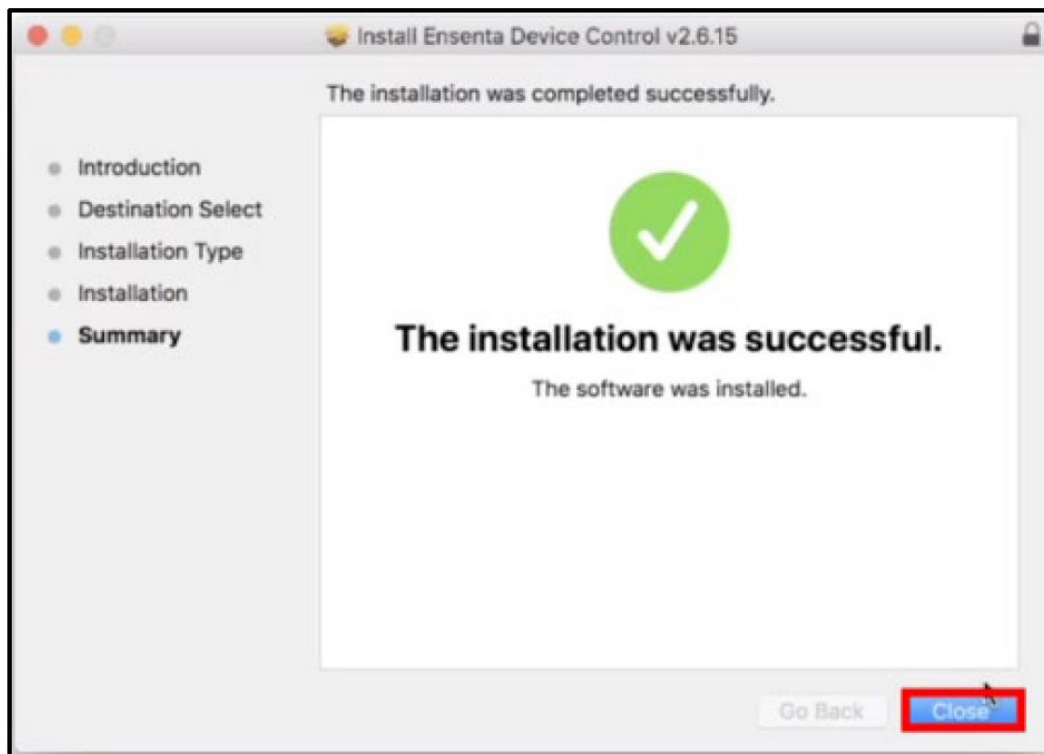
3. Click the **EnsentaDevice...pkg** download to launch the Device Control installer.
